

100,000 Peso Banknote: Five Identifying Features

On 31 March 2016, Banco de la República started circulating the new \$100 thousand peso banknote, the first of a new family of banknotes. The obverse features the image of President Carlos Lleras Restrepo (complying with article 10 of Act 1167 of 2007) together with the *barranquero* bird and the flower of the *sietecueros*. The reverse highlights Valle de Cocora in Quindio and the wax palm, our national tree. Learn about its characteristics and security elements in this video.
